GNORDC: Global Neuroscience Open Reusaable Data Challenge

- Three major organizations working on international data standards
 - INCF: International Neuroinformatics Coordinating Facility: Development, review and endorsement of standards; coordination of global neuroscience infrastructures
 - IBI: International Brain Initiative: Coordination across large international brain projects
 - GBC: Global Brain Consortium: Actively working on individual projects that require international data governance

Proposal

- Three organizations work together to create a challenge network with two goals: drive data reuse and to test and the global infrastructure, including data governance, by developing specific use cases
- Three components:
 - Ideation and team building: Bring together researchers to understand the current data landscape and start to think of grand challenge questions on top of open data
 - Challenge: Best reuse of existing data and for best "customer service"
 - **Feedback**: Results will be used to improve data FAIRness and quality, the overall usability of infrastructures and to identify areas where international data governance issues arise
